

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Introduction

Primarily I write piano / keyboard instruction books, most of which include a few tunes, but mainly theory and finger exercises. Due to the cost of producing printed books, I have generally stuck to my '*instructional*' theme and avoided adding too many tunes to keep the costs (and consequently the affordability) as low as possible. But clearly, I understand that at some point everyone is going to need song books to play from and to begin with these should be songs which they are familiar with. This book is my contribution, and the digital pdf version is *free* to download, print and copy - *my gift to you!* There is also a paperback edition which I have produced as economically as possible, but unfortunately, I cannot control production / publishing costs.

This book is primarily for keyboards with auto accompaniment, whereby the melody is played in the right hand and the backing accompaniment is triggered by the left-hand chords.

Consequently, the melody or top line is all that is written in the music notation (treble clef only) and the chords to be used by the accompaniment are indicated above. You will of course need to choose an appropriate rhythm / backing style and tempo on your keyboard as well as introductions / endings if required.

I have also produced a similar book (with mainly different tunes) where there is a simple bass clef for the left hand which is more suitable for anyone not wishing to use auto-accompaniment. See: https://learn-keyboard.co.uk/gonk_music_1.html and <https://learn-keyboard.co.uk/xmas.html>.

All the songs in this book are in the public domain as in all cases the composers have passed on many years ago or are unknown (traditional), but wherever they are known they are mentioned here in respect for their great works.

Where the key signature is other than **C major / A minor**, I have indicated this with an arrow to remind you.

Fingering

Recommended fingering has been added, but if you find any alternatives that suits you better, use it!

Loop Sections

In some of the pieces you will come across some '*loop section*' symbols. The first one (below) means that the whole piece should be repeated from the beginning.



The next one means that the bar (or bars) between the markers should be repeated.



And this one means that the piece should be repeated from the beginning, using the bar marked '1' the first time and the one marked '2' the second time.



Navigation

In the pdf version, if at any time you want to return to the '*Contents*' section, just click on the « found at the bottom of every page, then you can click on the then you want to view and get there instantly!




